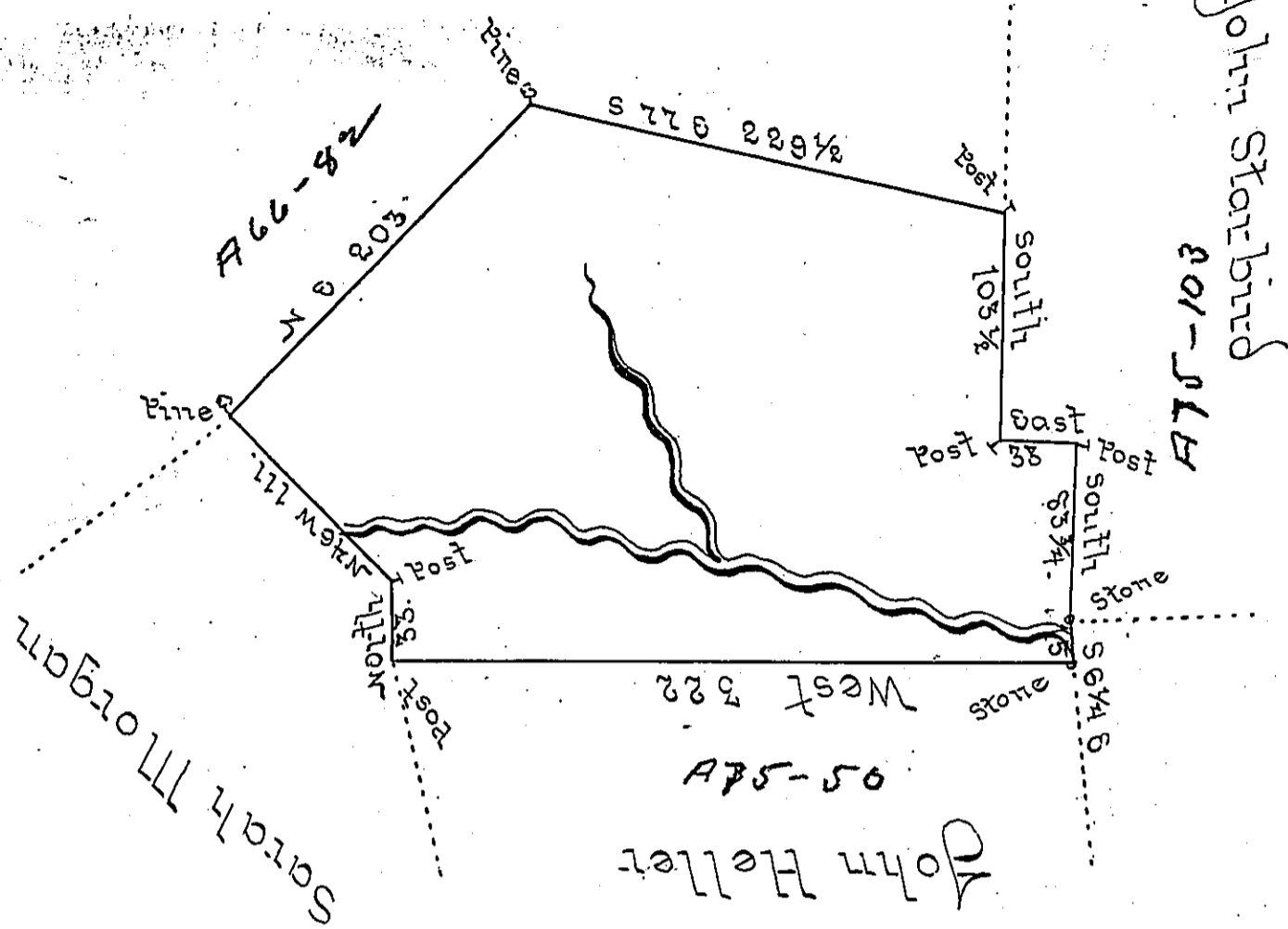


Vacant Land
