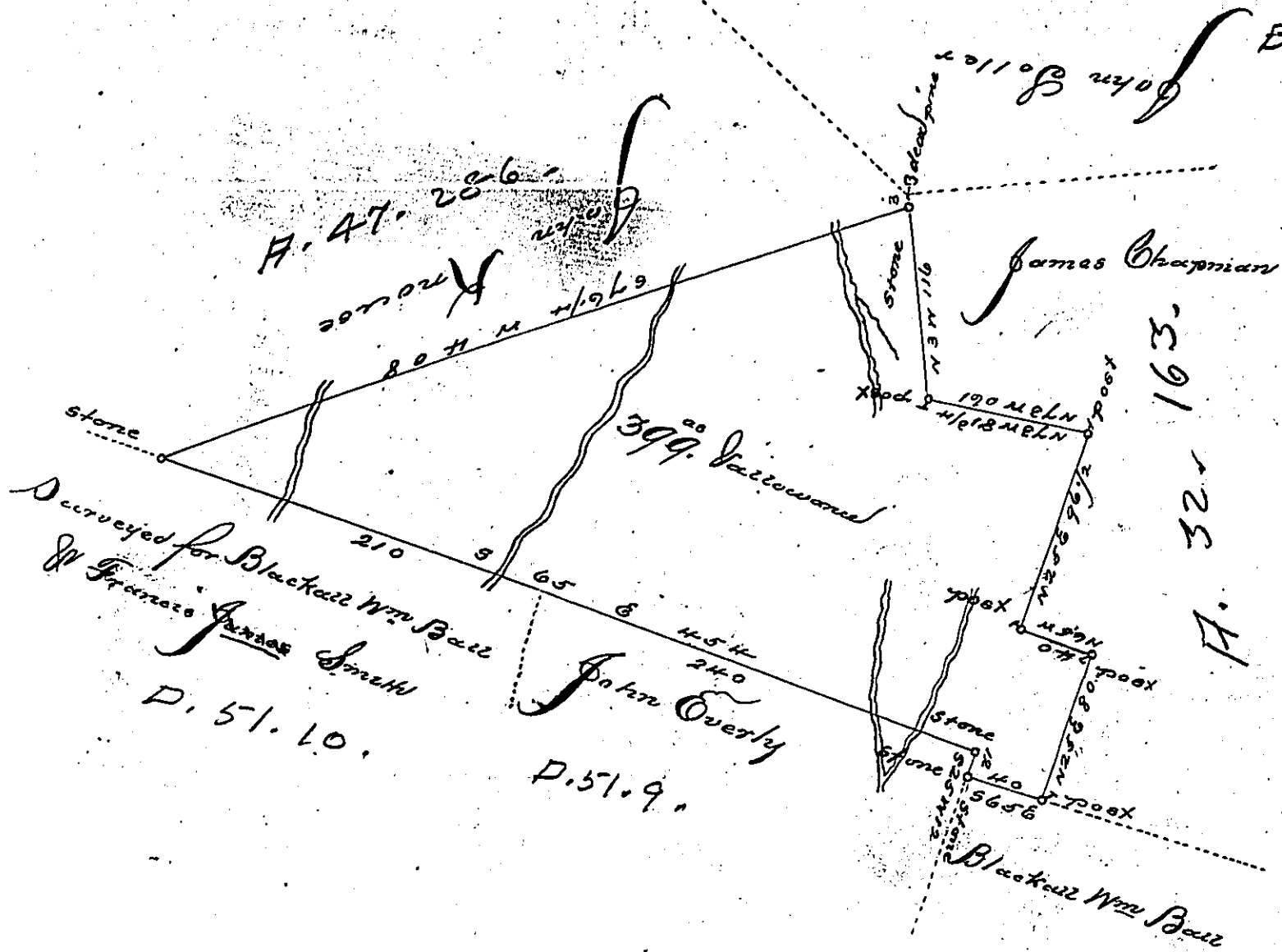


B. Grove - PIKE
