



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 18th day of March 1793 and order of survey rec<sup>d</sup> the 8th day of October 1850 I surveyed the 12th of October 1850 the above described tract of Land <sup>to John Nicholson</sup> situate adjoining Shoholy line in (formerly Upper Smithfield) now Dingman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County containing Eighty seven acres and thirty six perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c
