



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 3<sup>d</sup> of July 1784, and order of survey rec<sup>d</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1847. Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1847 to John Scott the above described Tract of Land situate in Lackawanna Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County on Masthope Creek about two miles from Delaware River. Including a Mill seat on the lower side of Coxes Meadow. Containing one hundred & six acres fifty six perches and allowance of six per cent for Road &c.
