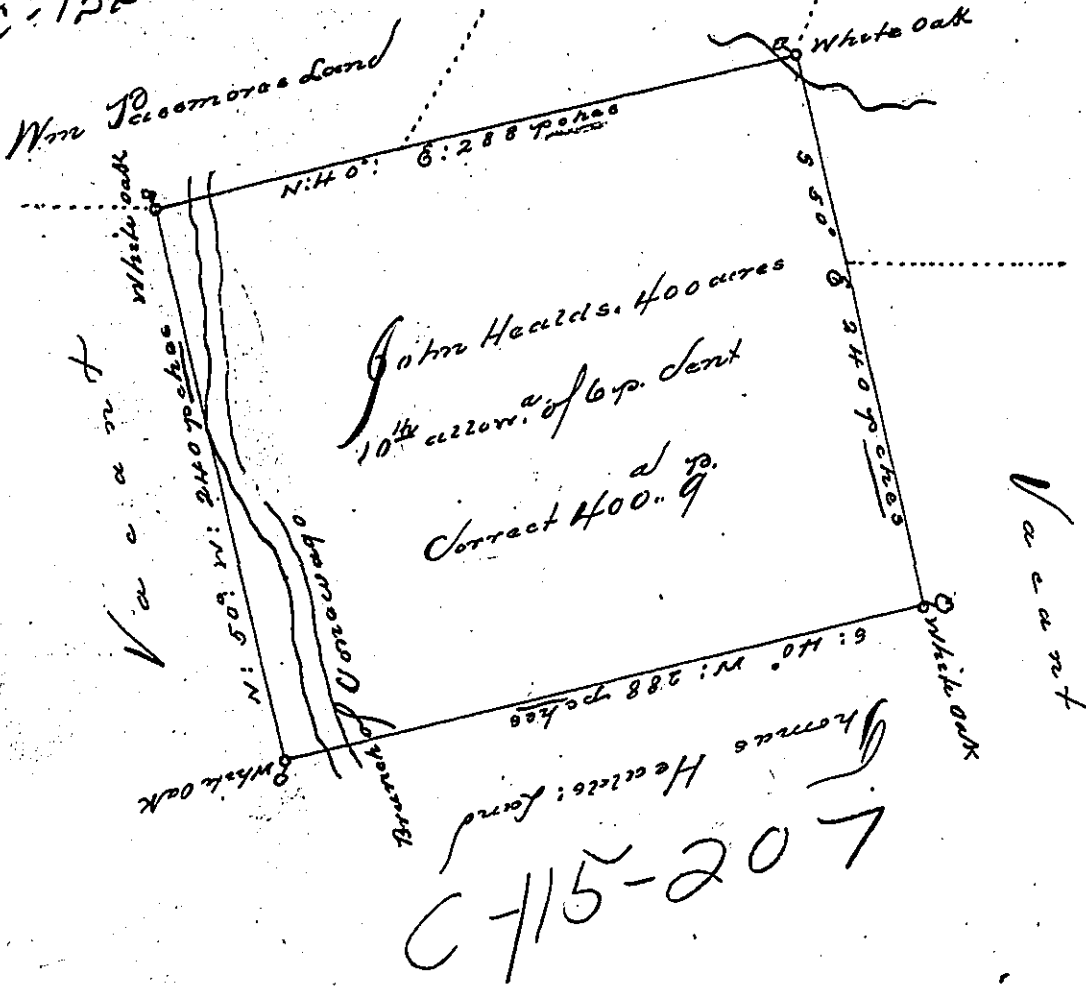

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries dated the first day of November anno Domini 1735 There is surveyed unto John Heard four hundred acres of Land with allowance of six p. Cent, in Lancaster County on the West side of Susquehanna River and begins at a White Oak a Corner of Thom's Heards Land Then by S. Land South forty degrees Westerly Two hundred and Eighty eight pches to a White Oak, Thence North fifty degrees Westerly Two hundred and forty pches to a White Oak a Corner of William Pasmore's Land Thence North forty degrees Easterly Two hundred and eighty eight pches to a White Oak Thence South fifty degrees Easterly Two hundred and forty pches to the place of Beginning.
