 & Connewango Creek in the County of Allegheny Containing three hundred  
 and ninety eight acres - one hundred and thirty six perches, and allowance of six per  
 Cent. Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> of October 1799. By Order of Resurvey of the 16<sup>th</sup> of  
 May 1799 and on a warrant granted to Jesse Pim dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of April  
 1793.
