



A Draught of an Island, situated in the River Susquehanna, Called
 Rock Island, in Conestogoe township Lancaster County opposite to
 Lands of Christian Shunk on the Lancaster Shore, about three hundred
 red yards below Blackwoods Island, & about one hundred & fifty
 yards from it to the Eastward of Perummon Island, Containing one hundred &
 and twenty perches strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant
 dated the 8th day of February Anno Dom 1822, granted to John Kending
 (by the name of John Kending son of Martin)
