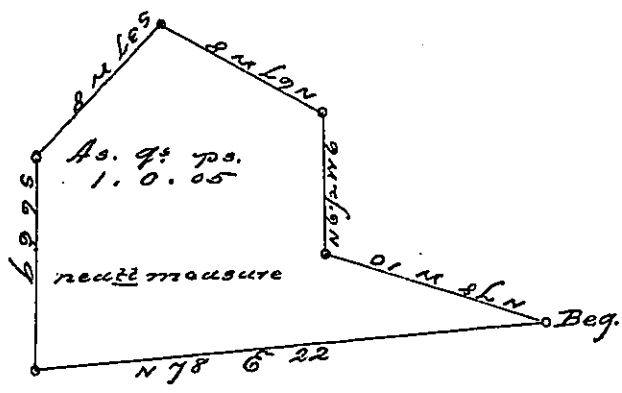

A Draught of an Island situated in the River Susquehanna in Manor Township Lancaster County, Called Rock Island, lying a West course from the Ring Rock which is at the Landing of Sowers Ferry, which is now owned by Jacob Charles & others lying about one hundred yards from the Lancaster Shore, containing one acre & five perches strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 25th of February 1822, granted to John Mellinger Senr. Examined & Certified the 3rd of May 1830
