



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietors. Dated the sixteenth day of May Anno Domini 1738. The above Described Tract of Land was surveyed unto William Woods in Hanover Township in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a post Thence North 70 degrees East by the Blue Mountain 203 perches to a Hickery. Thence South 30 degrees East by the Improvement of Jacob Brown 200 perches to a post.
