

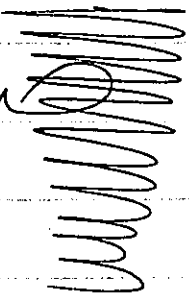

Acres 68 perches & the usual allowance this is part of a tract of land first surveyed  
the 19th day of November 1766. In pursuance of an order No 704, granted  
to Joseph Jacobs Dated the 2nd of August, 1766. the whole tract was  
then said to contain two hundred ninety eight acres & one quarter. This part  
resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 13th of July  
A.D. 1830
