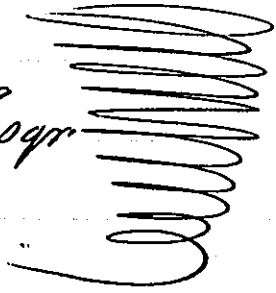


Draft of a Tract of Land, situated in Bratton Township, in the County of
