of the 29 January 1791  
entitled "An Act for granting Eight Hundred Dollars to Complander,  
Half Town & Big Tree, Seneca Chiefs in Trust for the Seneca  
Nation and for other purposes therein mentioned, and in-  
structions from the Governr & Surveyor General, I have  
surveyed to Complander, July 9th, 1795 the above described Island  
situated in the Allegheny River nearly opposite to an Indian Town  
called Junneshadago containing Sixty six acres fifty one perches  
Variance of six p. Cent &c.
