 surveyed to Complanter July 4th 1795. The above described Tract of Land

 & Conewango Creek in Allegheny County including an Indian Town  
 called Conewagayya or Hickory Town, containing six hundred & thirteen  
 acres One hundred & Forty Two perches & arrow of six p Cent & 1/2
