In pursuance and by virtue of an Act of the General Assembly entitled an Act for granting Eight Hundred Dollars to Comptroller, Half Town & Big Tree Seneca Chiefs in Trust for the Seneca Nation, and for other purposes therein mentioned, and instructions from the Governor & Surveyor General, I have surveyed July 2. 1795. To Comptroller the above described tract of Three hundred & Three acres, Eighty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. situated in District No 7 North and west of the Rivers Ohio, Allegheny & Conewango creek in Allegheny County above the mouth of Oil Creek
