



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Caleb Foucke for one hundred and Fifty acres of Land situate on the West Branch of Susquehanna River about four mile above Young Womans Town on the opposite side of the said Branch, I surveyed the above described Tract of Land the 29th day of November 1782, containing One hundred and Thirty ^{two} Acres & one hundred ps. & the usual allowance of six p. Ct. for Roads &c. Warrant dated the 30th July 1773.
