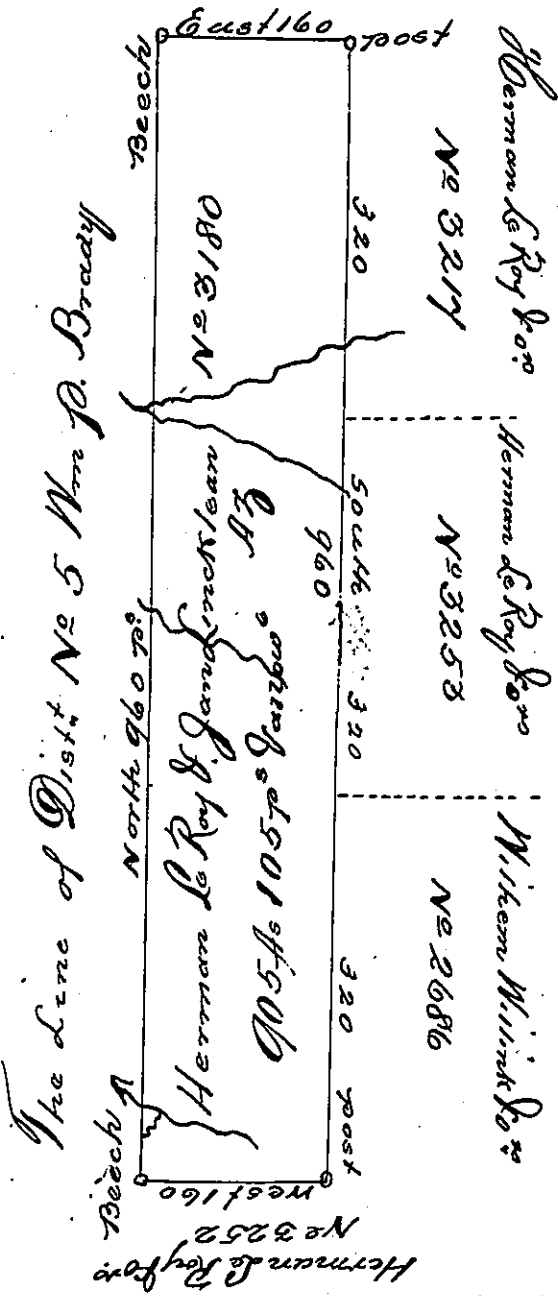


Herman Le Roy & Co.

Situated on the heads of the West Branch of Big Tobys creek, joining the line of District No 5 in the last purchase in District No. 4. Surveyed the sixteenth of August 1793. In pursuance of a Warrant No 3180 to Herman Le Roy and Jan Lircklean A. G. Dated the thirteenth day of December 1793. for 900<sup>00</sup> containing Nine hundred and five acres & one hundred & five perches & the usual allowance of six M. Ct. for Roads &c.
