Called the (Isle of Nope, lying a South course from the Isle of Plover a West course from Christian Wislers Point and a North East course from the Dock Island, about a mile from the Main Land on both sides, Containing forty Two perches, Strictly measured surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 16th day of November A. D. 1818, granted to John & Rudolph Wisler
