
Donegall Township in Lancaster County



By Vistice of two Warrants from the Proprietaries, one of them granted to the said Jacof Efoner bearing Date the 12th Day of the Month Called November Anno Down 1760. The other granted to the Degatees of Nehemiah Allen bearing Date the 11th. Day of the 12th Month 1701 the three Belander above de-wiled were Surveyed to the eaid Jacob Yoner, Situate between the Township of Donegallin Dancaster County and the Township of Manchester in York County and Server Bonewaga Falle and the month of Codorne Creek. The lovernost was Surveyed the 22nd and the two upermost the 24th Days of the 11th Month 1760.
