



Situated on a Branch of the Shawanese Cabin Creek in St. Clair Township (formerly Cumberland) now Bedford County containing Two hundred and fifty five Acres with the allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed for James Elliot the 21st. Day of January 1800 (along old lines which appear to have been run about the year 1767) on application dated September 15th. 1766. No. 1258.

N.B. The dotted lines represent Surveys which interfere with James Elliot's Survey, No. 3. on Warrant Dated \_\_\_\_\_ in the name of John Riley 100 a. ret'd. June 18th. 1794; No. 4. 200 a & alls. Surveyed Feby. 7th. 1788, in pursuance of Commissioners Sale and on Location in the name of John Pollock dated September 15th. 1766. No. 1257.
