Cent for roads being part of a larger tract of Two hundred and twenty four acres and fifty seven perches and allowance &c. which was surveyed in pursuance of an order of Survey granted to James Erwin Dated September 5th. 1767 No. 4355

Resurveyed and laid off from the other part of the tract for Jacob Stouwer June 5th. 1811.
