



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the thirtieth day of October 1734 Surveyed unto William Wirt a tract of Land Situate in Old Course Choppin in the County of Philada. Beginning at a White Oak a corner of Gabriel Shoolars land standing on the East Bank of Perkiomee Creek thence by sd. Shoolars land North East ninety one perches to a post thence by sd. Shoolars land South East thirty perches to a white oak thence by sd. Shoolars land North East Twenty Six perches to a post a corner of William Smiths land thence by the same South East one hundred and nine perches to a post a corner of George Cowkills land thence by the same South West Seventy two perches to an Alder Tree standing on the Bank of sd. Creek thence up the same to the place of Beginning containing Seventy two acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent.
