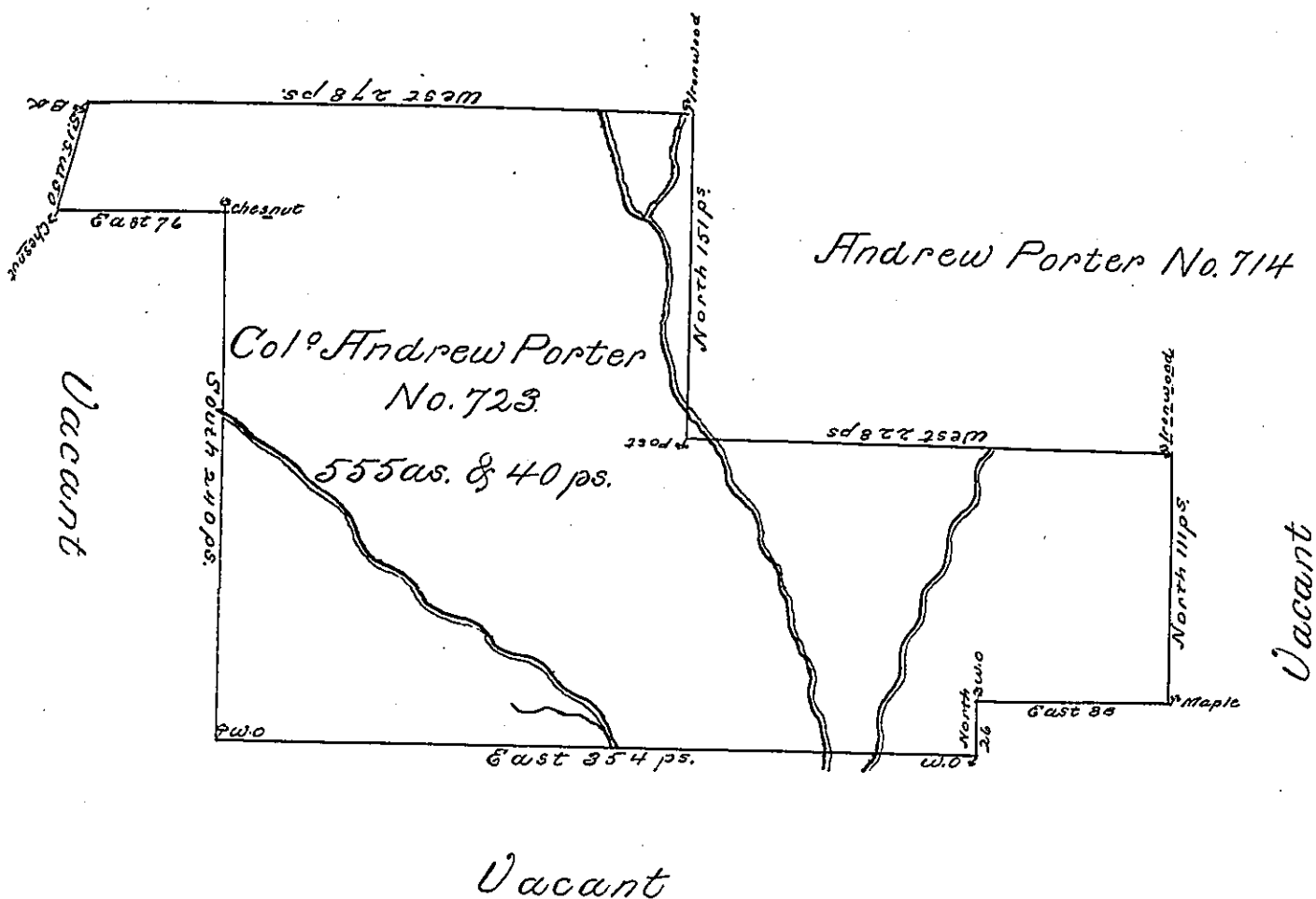


Col^o Andrew Porter No. 726

A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the North side of Bycanshoning Creek about four Miles up Town Creek adjoining Lands of Andrew Porter on the North in the County of Northumberland* within the last Purchase made of the Indians Containing five hundred and fifty five acres and forty perches with the allowance of six ps. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed for Col^o Andrew Porter the 16th. Day of June 1786. In pursuance of a Warrant Dated November 26th. 1785 No. 723
