Situate in Fawn Township York County, ^{then called Lancaster County} on the South Fork of Muddy Creek, Beginning at a Post on the South Side of the said Fork & near the Mouth of a small Branch & running thence as above described; Including an Old Mill built by Charles Bond, but no other Survey join'd to it, at the Time I believe.
