



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Second\* day of August 1734 Surveyed unto Hans Clemens a tract of Land Situate in Salford Township in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post a Corner of Tilman Colp's land thence by land of Andrew Ledraah North East Eighty Eight perches to a post in a line of sd. Clemens other land thence by the same South East one hundred and Eight perches to a post thence by land of Hans Rieff South West Eighty Eight perches to a post in a line of sd. Tilman Colp thence by the same North West one hundred and Eight perches to the place of Beginning containing Fifty Six acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent. Surveyed s. b. 26. 1734 By  
Nichs. Scull.

Frederick Altorf has paid the Consideration money &c & another Warrant dated the day of October 1739 is since issued to Return the same &c for the use of Fredk. Altorf
