By Virtue of a Warrant from the Honble the Proprietaries bearing date the 5th day of November 1737 Surveyed on the 21st day of April 1738 to John Adamson a Tract of Land situate on a branch of Coopers Creek in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Chestnut oak in a line of a tract of Land laid out on the Lottery Scheme thence by that and the Manor of Richland West 262 perches to a post thence by a tract laid out to ~~John~~ Peter Lester North 60 perches to a post thence by the same East 100 perches to a post thence by the same North 60 perches to a post thence by the Lands of Randall Iden and John McCoy East 162 perches to a Hickory thence by Vact. Land South 120 perches to the place of beginning Cont. 150 acres with allowance of Six pcent.
