Warrant granted to James Fizzon for 100 acres joining James Sharps two Tracts to the Eastward and the South Mountain on Philemon Hughes's Run bearing date 8th July 1743, appears fairly to locate a part of the above Tract marked B, but no evidence of any person now claiming under said Warrant.
