



Situated in Newburg township in the County of York, containing as above set forth, seventy-six acres fifty perches and the usual allowance of six p. Cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 231^{ac} and allowance of Land originally surveyed by Thomas Arnot, late d.f. in pursuance of the Application of James Trevelick N^o 3562 for 300^{ac} dated the 31th of April 1767. Resurveyed by the old lines and the above part divided off from the said larger tract by John Eichelberger late d.f. on the 13th day of March 1800. And now at the request of John Hoff the present owner of the said part it is examined, calculated and found correct and is returned for Confirmation 7th January 1822.
