Cent. situate on the North bank of Conemaugh River adjoining Lands of Thomas N. Sloan, John Hamerton and ~~and~~ Widow Doneke, all in right of Thomas Truman including an improvement made in the year 1797, in Black Lick Township Indiana County, By Warrant of the twenty sixth day of April A. D. 1810.
