



Surveyed the above described Tract of Land the twentieth day of June A.D. 1838 for John Woodley by Virtue of his Warrant for 25 acres, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> November 1837. Containing nineteen acres & sixty eight perches & allowed of six per cent. Situate on the East side of Loyalsock Creek about six miles above the mouth of Plunkets Creek in Plunkets Creek Township Lycoming County & bounded as above described.

Note, the red lines show an interference with a Survey on a warrant to Richard Rogers, dated 15<sup>th</sup> May 1838.
