



A Draft of a Tract of Land Situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin. Containing fifty three acres and 125 perches and an allowance proportional to six p. cut for Roads &c. Survey'd May 9th 1786 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Horner Junr bearing date the 19th day of April 1786.

I see a judgment of the Board of Property ordering about 1 1/2 acres to be cut off the above Survey, and added to that of Adam Richardson; but by a subsequent agreement of the parties, Adam has convey'd the same piece back to said Horner, with request that ~~the~~ both surveys should be Return'd as first made, Mr. Horner to produce s^d Conveyance on application for a Patent M.H.O.
