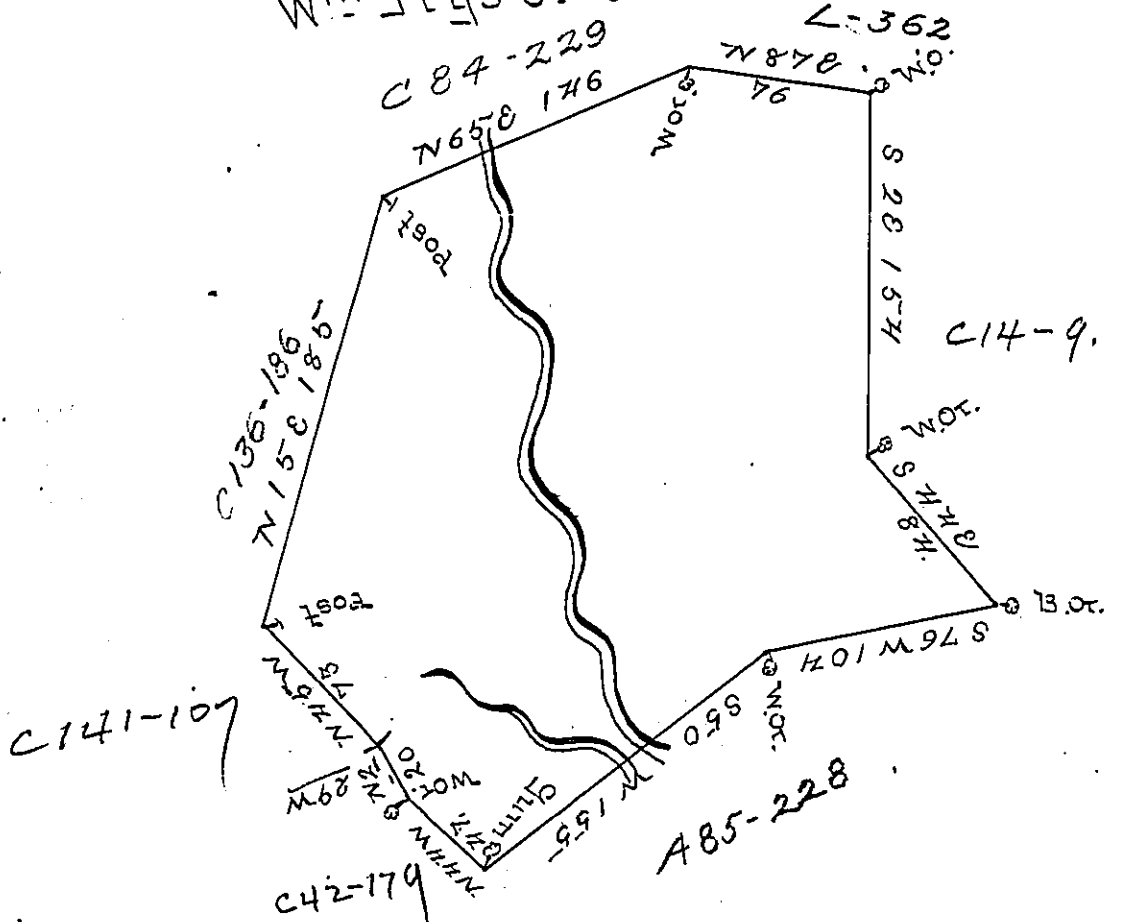

The above is of a Survey made Jun<sup>o</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> 1755 in pursuance of a  
 Ver<sup>o</sup> Certificate which is as follows viz. We the Commissioners  
 for ajsobly claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Mon-  
 ongalia, yohagania & Ohio do hereby Certify that William  
 Fry is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County  
 of yohagania situate on the Waters of Peters Creek to include his  
 Settlement made in the year 1755 given under our hands at Coxes  
 fort the fifth day of February 1750 & in the fourth year of the  
 Common Wealth
