



The above is a Draught of a Survey made February 3^d 1789 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Wolverton Dated November 17th 1787 in the County of Washington Containing 272 acres with an Allowance According to Law Called Sugar Tree Orchard. Please to take Notice that Daniel Griffon Robert Brother to the said Daniel, Claims the above tract of Land in virtue of an improvement Made by Zulus Griffin Deceased Father of the said Daniel and Robert -
