May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1783,



The dotted line to a heap of stones is where John Bell claims to & says was there fixed by Mr. Churchman, which if allow'd to be a corner will reduce the West line to 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  ps cannot find any marked trees upon either of the lines claimed by Bell or Hetherington, except one in Cunningham's line which is so far distant from the Disputed Corner & no certain corner in the road between Cunningham & Hetherington makes it uncertain & doubtful where the corner ought to be.
