



In pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785, entitled; "an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised the troops by this Commonwealth;" and by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the 17th day of June, 1786, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and allowance for roads, &c. N^o 1572, situate in District N^o 2, on the west side of the Alleghany river, in the County of Westmoreland.
