



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Wheatfield situate on the South side of the West Branch of Susquehanna adjoining and above Land surveyed to Adam Hubley Junior opposite to a remarkable Grove of young Locusts about sixteen Miles below the Mouth of the Chest Creek between twelve and thirteen Miles above Chingledamouche Old Town in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and seventy nine Acres and the usual Allowance of six P Cent. for Roads &c surveyed the 30th Day of June 1773 for Adam Zantzinger in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 12th Day of May of the same Year by
