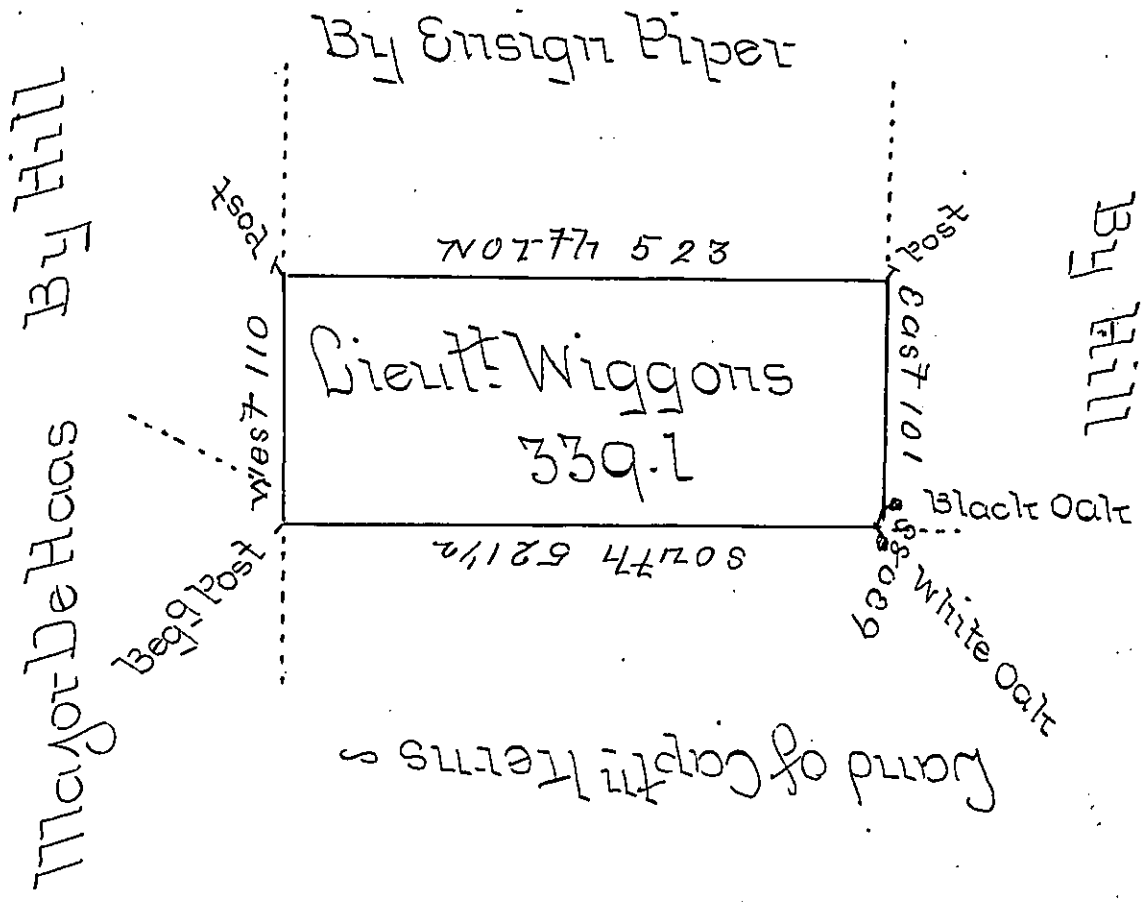


The Breadth & Length of this Draft are not laid down from the Same Scale. Says Ho
