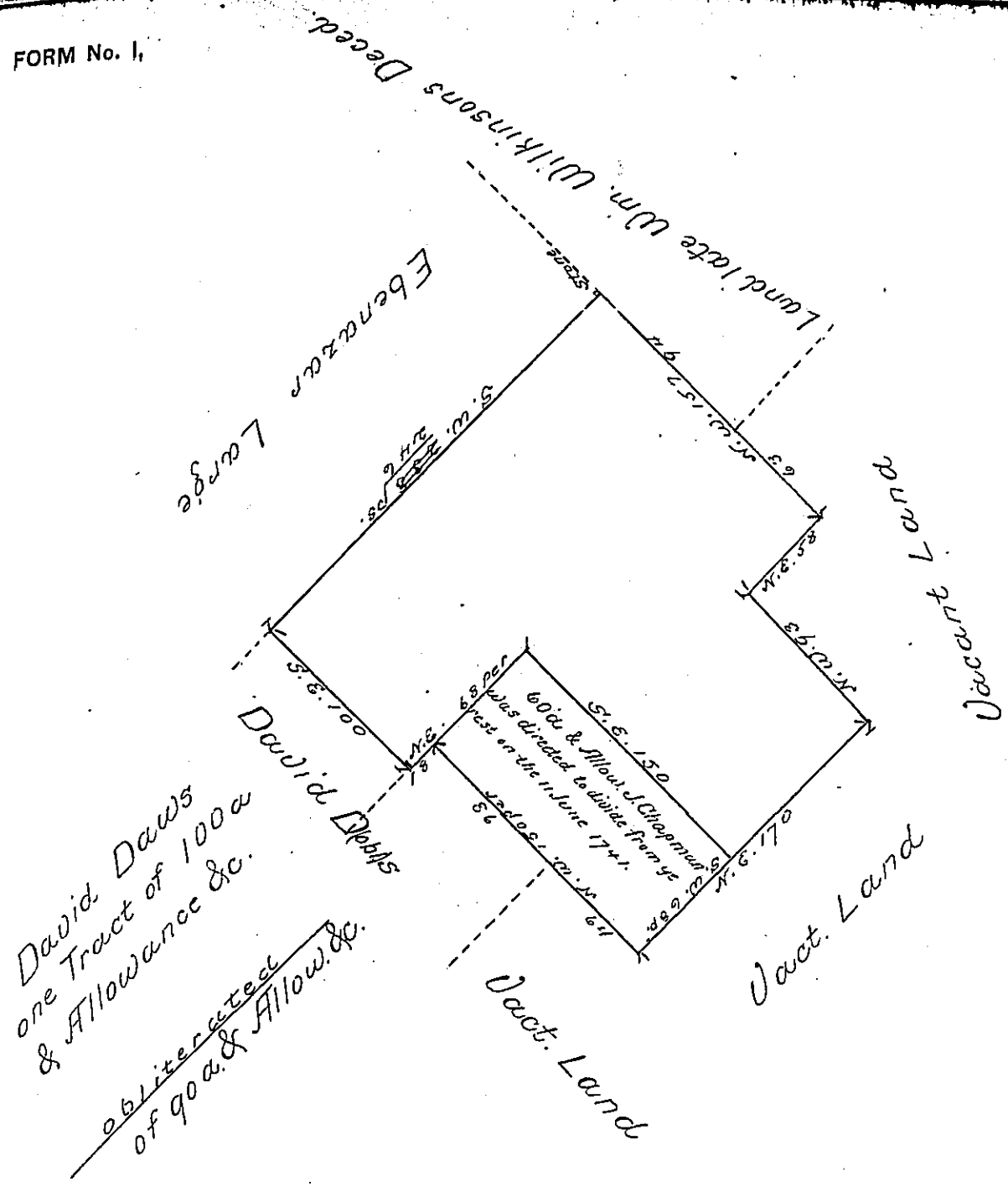


Both (ob1.) signed to Thos. Kendall
