



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 31st. day of July 1734 Surveyed to Robert Pasbrough the above tract of Land Situate on a Branch of Maiden Creek in the County of Philada. Containing 250 acres with the usual allowance of Six pch.
