Cherry July 9th 1785 in pursuance of a certificate obtained from the Commissioners for adjusting claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohiogania & Ohio and regularly entered as will appear from the following Certificates

"Surveyors office Yohiogania County Virga. Feb. 28. 1780.

"Thos. Cherry produced a Certif. from ye Com. for adjusting Claims & settling Titles to unpatented Lands in ye Counties Yohiogania Monongalia and Ohio for four hundred acs of Land in this County, on Raccoon Creek, to include his Settlement, made in the year 1774.
