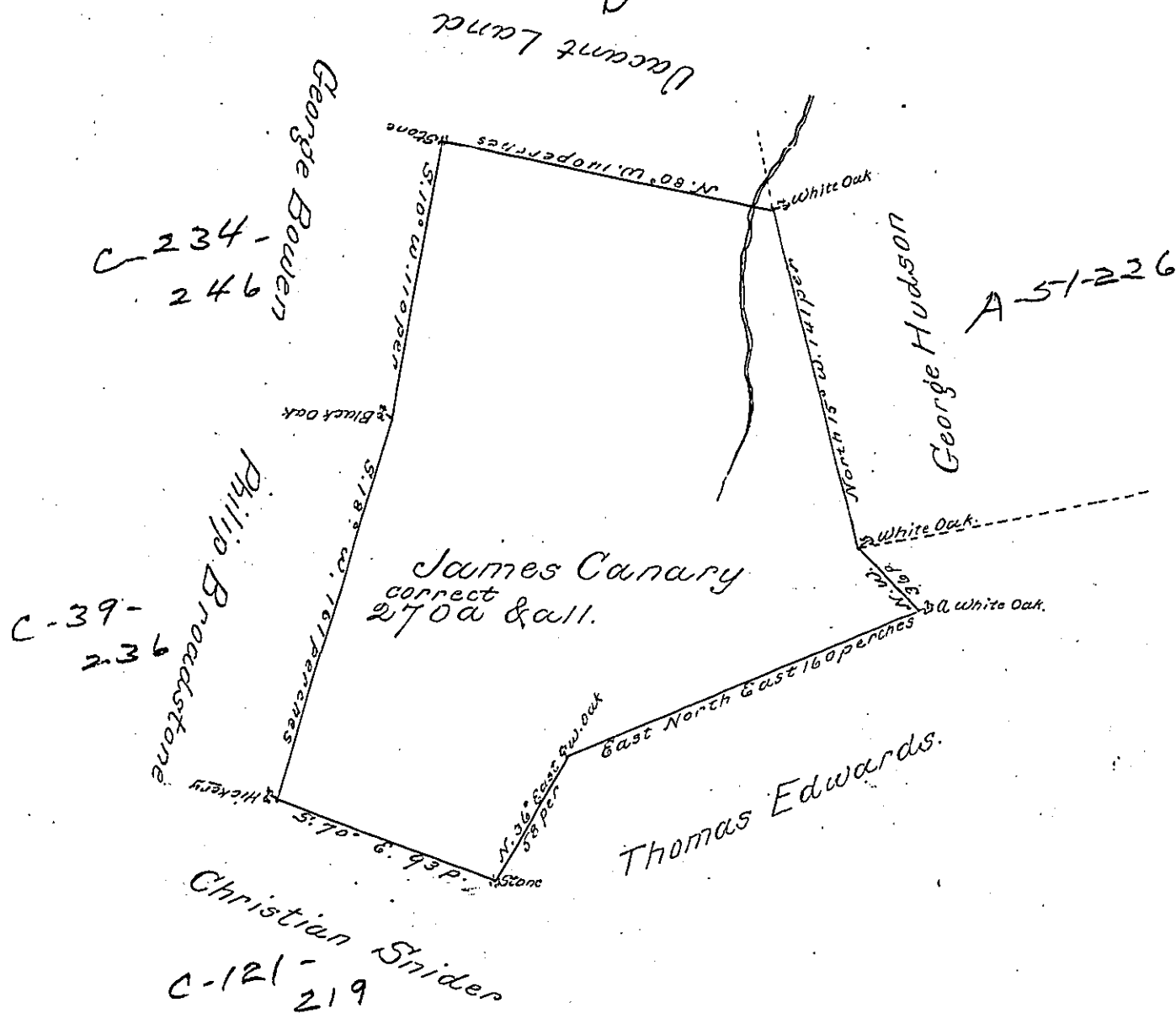

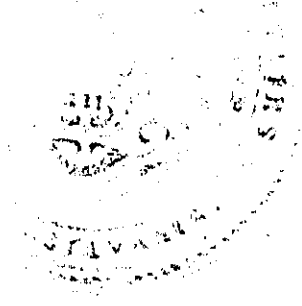

The above described Tract of Land was surveyed unto James Canary in Erie township in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak thence South 10 degrees west by the Land of Philip Broadstone 161 perches &c. Containing Two Hundred and Seventy ~~three~~ acres beside ye allowance of Six pcent.
