



This Tract of Land surveyed By Vertue of a warrant from the proprietor Thomas Penn bearing date the 14th day of February 1733/4 Beginning at a marked white oak standing in the line of John Stooks Land on the East side of a branch of Tohickney which runeth throu the said Stooks land then west by the said Land Eighty four perches to another white oak marked with FC and notched standing by the side of an old Road which leadeth to Drewn from perkesoy then South one hundred perches by vacand Land to a heap of stones then East eighty four perches by vacand land to a black oak marked for a corner then north one hundred perches by vacand land to the place of beginning containing fifty acres of Land with some allowance for roads surveyed on the _____ of March in the year 1733/4 Lying in the Great Swamp in Bucks County Returned by _____
