



By Virtue of two Warrants from the Honorable Proprietaries bearing Date respectively on the $\frac{15^{\text{th}}}{100}$ & $\frac{27^{\text{th}}}{200}$ Days of Novr. 1740 I have survey'd and laid out unto Richd Cox on Bermudian Creek in the County of Lancaster on the west side Susquehanna river five hundred acres of land with allowance of Six p Cent Beginning at a poplar by said creek Thence north fifty degrees easterly one hundred and forty pches to a white oak Thence north forty degrees westerly Three hundred and twenty eight pches to a white oak thence south fifty degrees westerly Two hundred and Eighty ~~4~~ pches to a Blac Oak thence South forty degrees easterly two hundred and Sixty eight pches to a white oak Thence north fifty degrees easterly ninty six perches to a Gum tree by the said creek thence down the same Traversing the Several courses thereof near about ninty pches to the place of Beginning
