By Virtue of a Warrant from the proprietaries, dated the 15th day of February Anno Dom. 1737 Surveyed to Robert Chambers a Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Paxton in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a Spanish oak Simon Edgall Corner thence East by South 98 ps. to a post thence South by west 158 ps. to a post thence ~~west~~ west by north 131 ps. to a Spanish oak standing by ye river Susquehanna (ye Proprietor Corner) thence up ye said River by its several courses 162 ps. to the place of beginning Containing 94 acres & 1/2 and the allowance of Six acres pcent for Road & highways
