



By Virtue of a Warrant from the proprietaries bearing Date the Twelfth day of October Anno Domini 1739 Surveyed To Richard Allison a tract of Land on the Branches of Sickasa-lunga Creek in the Township of Donegal Beginning at a marked Corner white oak thence North 63 deg west 145 per 2 1/2 to a post thence South 27 deg west 379 per to a post thence South 85 deg East 157 per to a post thence North 27 deg East 320 per to the place of Beginning containing three Hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six acres p^{ct}. for Roads &c. Surveyed the 12th Day of October Anno Domini: 1739.
