



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property, dated the 16th. day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3d. day of July 1772 for James Brown on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number three hundred & Sixteen Containing in Breadth East and West on the North Side of Elderberry Street Sixty feet, and in length North and South on the West side of Fawn Street Two hund. and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Elderberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Fawn Street, Northward by Billberry Alley, and Westward by Lot No. Three hundred and fifteen - Returned into the Secretarys office the 24th. day of October 1776 for Ann Lawrence
