



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 4th April 1792 Surveyed the 10th December 1802 to Jacob Weiss the above described tract of land situate on the West side of the Indian path from Gnattenhutter to Wioning on the broad mountain including a run issuing out of Weiss's little pine Swamp, and two (ob) markable Land springs in the County of Northampton containing three hundred and ninety-nine acres thirty perches and the allowance of Six pcent Yea.

Being the same tract Surveyed and returned for Joseph Savage by Warrant of the 12th. December 1792.
