



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the 21st day of April 1794 granted to Frederick Sweitzer, was surveyed on the fifteenth day of March 1824 the above described tract of land containing 403 acres 131 perches and allowance of Six percent for Roads &c. Situate in Sadshury township Crawford County - Being the same tract, as appears by the record of the adjoining surveys, which was originally settled by Hugh McConnell, and now claimed by his heirs and another person.
