



In pursuance of a warrant dated 2nd Jany. 1794 surveyed the 27th. day of May 1794 to David Caldwell the above described tract of Land situate on the heads of a small stream that empties into the Delaware River north of the State line & about a mile & an half southwest of the Delaware River where it crosses the State line in Northampton County containing Four hundred & twenty one acres & thirty six perches & the allowance of six p. Cent.
