



Draught of forty eight acres and one hundred and forty three perches of land with six per Cent for roads situate in Pennanock Township in Mifflin county, which is part of a tract surveyed for William Buchanan and John Smith in pursuance of their Warrants dated 3^d Feb^y and 10th April 1755. Resurvey 3^d Nov^r 1808. Examined 15th June 1809.

Note the above described land was included by a survey made in pursuance of warrant to William Purdy dated 30th December 1755 and is patented on the same; but, which title is now relinquished, by order of Court and jury to that of Buchanan & Smith.
