



A Draught of a Tract of Land called "Peach Vale" situate on a Branch of Weisoughtking or Pine Creek above other Land on said Creek Surveyed for said William Deady and about four Miles from the North East Branch of Susquehanna River in the County of Northumberland Containing Two hundred and fourteen Acres & a half and the Usual Allowance of six Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 20th day of September 1774 for William Deady in right and as part of One Thousand Acres granted to John Jennings by a Special Relocating Order dated the 16th day of December 1775 in lieu of the Application No 5315 for the same Quantity.
